## FAQ's

How many books do I have to read? In order to "pass" you must choose one square and record that activity.

**Do I have to read one specific book for my grade?** No. BUT.... If you have an Honors class, the teacher **may** expect you to read a specific book.

**Will there be a test?** Sorry, no testing this year. We will trust you. If you read a book or do one of the activities on the tic-tac-toe board, and submit it, you will get credit.

**I don't want to do the Google Form. Is there a paper copy?** Yes. Go to the <u>paper copy link</u> and print one out. Copies are also available at the school.

**I love to read. Can I just read books? Or do I have to listen to a podcast or Ted Talk?** Every square gives you an option. You can choose the activity OR read (or listen to) a book of your choice. If you choose to read more than 9 books and want to continue, add to the <u>Governor's Reading</u> <u>Challenge Google Form</u>.

**What is the Governor's Reading Challenge?** Every year, the CT Library Association and the Governor put out a challenge. Schools compete to see who can read the most books per student over the summer. We will participate in 2022. There are book suggestions if you are interested, but ANY book you read will be counted!

What items are counted for the <u>Governor's Reading Challenge</u>? Only books, graphic novels, and audiobooks are counted for the Challenge. All other categories are part of our tic-tac-toe.

**Box 1 says "Nutmeg Award Nominee." What does that mean?** Every year, students at different grade levels are given 10 great book suggestions. Students get to vote on their favorite book in April. For 2023, these are the books: <u>Nutmeg Award Nominees for High School</u>. For summer reading, you can choose to read one of these or any winner or nominee from a past list.

## HELP! How do I use the Google Form?

- Enter your full name and grade > Choose the category > Fill in the information.
- When you are done with that section, you can say "I'm done" or, if you did another activity, "record another activity." Do not change the "name and grade" answers.
- If you're done, click I'M DONE FOR NOW. Answer the tic-tac-toe question and finish your session. You can return another time if you choose to do more.
